Pitch In:

You will be allocated a duty – check the duty list each day for what you need to help with. If you aren't allocated anything check with the Trip Leader or Custodian if there is anything you can do to help – many hands make light work

Be Considerate:

- Clean up after yourself, keep your stuff tidy as you may be sharing a room with others.
- Be considerate of others in the lodge –if people are trying to sleep don't make too much noise near the bunkrooms. No noise near the bunkrooms after 10pm
- All Junior and Child members must be under the care of a parent – please take responsibility for your teens and make sure they are behaving appropriately.
- **All parents:** If kids in the lodge are not behaving in an acceptable manner please sort it out, **Kids:** If you wouldn't do it at your house don't do it here. Look after the lodge
- When you leave, ensure your bunk room is clean and tidy (vacuum, dust, empty bins, clean your bathrooms) for the next person
- No ski boots/poles beyond the wet entry thanks

Safety:

- If staying at Tukino or Iwikau, please let someone know if you are going outside/leaving the lodge – we don't want you getting lost in a blizzard
- At night, pack a grab bag for an emergency exit in case of fire (it has happened!) Include:
 - Car keys (in jacket pocket)
 - Wallet & Phone
 - Medication
 - Spectacles
 - Torch
 - Beside your bed: Waterproof tramping or walking boots
